

Read carefully the family story in your card. (*pause*) Close your eyes for a moment and imagine you are one of the members of the family described in your card. Imagine, how old you are (*pause*), what you look like (*pause*), what you like doing (*pause*) and what you don't (*pause*).

Imagine where you live (*pause*), what your room looks like (*pause*), if you go to school or to work (*pause*). Imagine if you have friends (*pause*), close friends (*pause*), if they are boys or girls (*pause*), what you like eating (*pause*), if you miss something important from another country (*pause*) and what your dream is (*pause*).

Now think about the role you are playing and try to answer these questions
– about this person:

Can you speak more than 1 language?

Do you have souvenirs from the places you have lived in before?

Can you go to school?

When did you last talk to your grandparents?

Do you know where you will live next year?

What language do you speak with them?

Can you build houses or do some other job?

Do you play a musical instrument?

Do the children in your family need to work for money?

Do you like music?

Does your family have to worry about money every day?

Are you good at math? (*pause*)

Do you have enough money to live comfortably?

Do you know what your character looks like?

Now look for other family members of yours – people with the same family cards. Introduce yourself to each other. In a moment you'll start your adventure together. (*pause*)

Have you found other members of your family? Come to me then.

The Gamemaster reads out the surnames of the families from the Character Cards and hands in to the participants the envelopes, containing tasks stripes. Each family receives their own envelope (the surnames of the families are written on the envelopes).
